**Fruit Tree Spray Program**

**Apply dormant oil spray in late Winter (Feb-March) while trees are still dormant. Good time to do any necessary pruning as well.**

<b><u>Apple &amp; Pear Trees Spray Schedule</u></b>	<b><u>Peach, Plum, Cherry, Apricot &amp; Nectarine Trees Spray Schedule</u></b>
1 <sup>st</sup> Spray- When new growth appears	1 <sup>st</sup> Spray- Pink bud stage
2 <sup>nd</sup> Spray- Pink bud stage	2 <sup>nd</sup> Spray- After petal fall
3 <sup>rd</sup> Spray- After petals	3 <sup>rd</sup> Spray- 10-14 days later
4 <sup>th</sup> Spray- 10-14 days later	4 <sup>th</sup> Spray- Every 10-14 days up to 7 days harvest.
5 <sup>th</sup> Spray- Every 10-14 days up to 7 days before harvest.	

**For Peach Leaf Curl**

Timing is Important.

F-Stop (replaces Lime Sulphur) should be applied in October or November after leaf drop and another application in late Winter in conjunction with a Dormant Oil Spray.

Remove and destroy infected leaves in Fall.
